A 35,500 square-foot strip of stores in Syosset was sold for \$15.55 million.

The 25 retail stores make up most of the shopping in [Syosset's downtown](#) just north of the Long Island Rail Road station.

Adam Silber of [Silber Investment Properties](#) represented the seller 700 W. 178 Associates and the buyer Syosset Station Inc. In May 2006, Silber brokered the sale of the same property for about \$13.25 million.
